In terms of online learning management, our system is setup with:


- Discussions that are based on CHED General Education subjects recommended-OBE-objective or DepEd MELC-focus for the week.

 - ✓ Ensuring standardized quality of learning delivery for all students.




CLASS SETUP


One (1) specific class setup for each section of each subject with the respective teachers exercising a greater degree of academic freedom by having their own style of interactive class facilitation/delivery.

To further support private schools, Ascendens Asia offers a "Pay-Later" program*, where schools can choose to pay within the second month up to the first Monday of the 4th month of the academic year OR under monthly installment terms.
